we herein announce the guidelines and protocol for visitation in accordance with the holistic living principles of the Sacred Ancestral Temple of Kwa-Ta-Man-I.

In honor of the essence of life and supreme love, as we forward wholesome health and well-being, the natural beauty of the body temple and higher-peace thoughts and reasoning in action, we requ<mark>est</mark> that all who enter the Mount Hope grounds respect the protocol as stated:

- 1. Visitation by appointment, between 9 am to 12 noon and 1 pm to 4 pm, unless otherwise arranged.
- 2. We do not support artificial, superficial or cosmetic altering of one's body temple. This includes perming, bleaching, and dyeing one's hair, tattoos, body piercings, make-up, nail polish, perfumes, and other artificial scents and smells. If one has altered one's natural hair, please wear a head wrap or covering. If one has tattoos, please cover the marked area if possible.
- 3. Please do not bring food substances, drinks or snacks on the Mount Hope grounds. No cooked foods, no cans, bottles or packages, no alcoholic beverages, drugs, intoxicating substances to smoke, inhale or otherwise ingest are allowed.
- 4. We do not support the slaughter and bloodshed of animals. request that visitors refrain from wearing leather items and other animal by-products during their visit. No pets allowed.
- 5. Please do not enter any living quarters or unattended areas on these grounds unless escorted by a representative.
- 6. Please do not pick the fruits, vegetation or disturb the wildlife on the grounds. Safety is a priority during your visit to the private property of this sacred site.
- 7. In honor of the divine law of reciprocation and respect for our sacred ancestral cultural traditions, each and every visitor is required to make a financial offering.
- 8. We note that any visits to the adjacent pyramid structure that houses the Sacred Ancestral Temple of Kwa-Ta-Man-I will follow the same protocol as stated above.
